PROS	REASONS (EXAMPLES)
It's a good way to learn about them.	You can see how they behave.
You help conserve them.	You give them food and a place to live.
CONS	REASONS (EXAMPLES)
Owners don't know how to look after them.	Books are not always accurate.
They need special food and habitats.	They get sick when they do not live in their natural habitats.
They can be dangerous.	They are wild.
